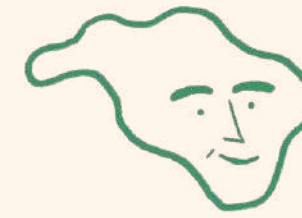
Grumpy Cloud
