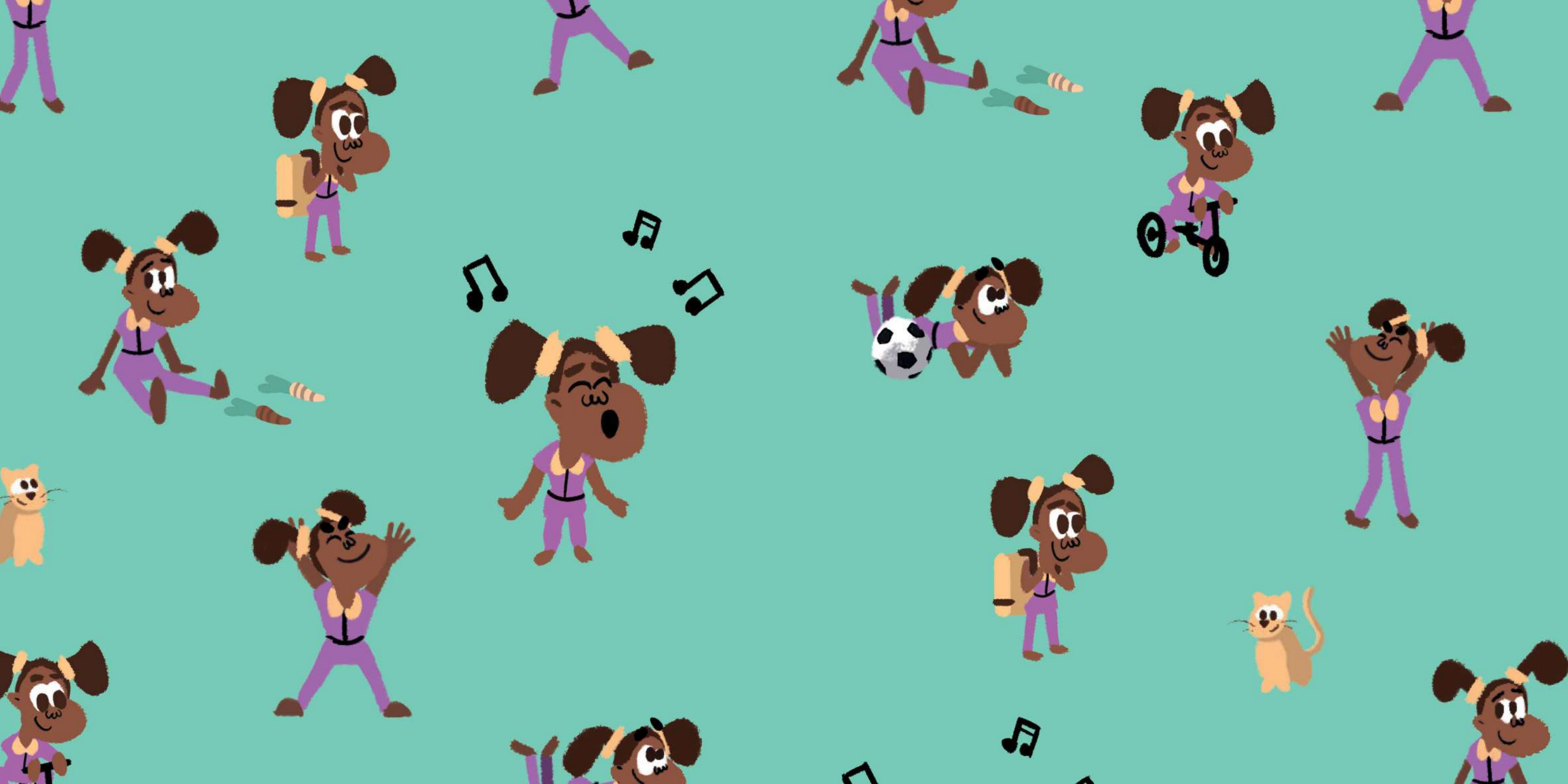

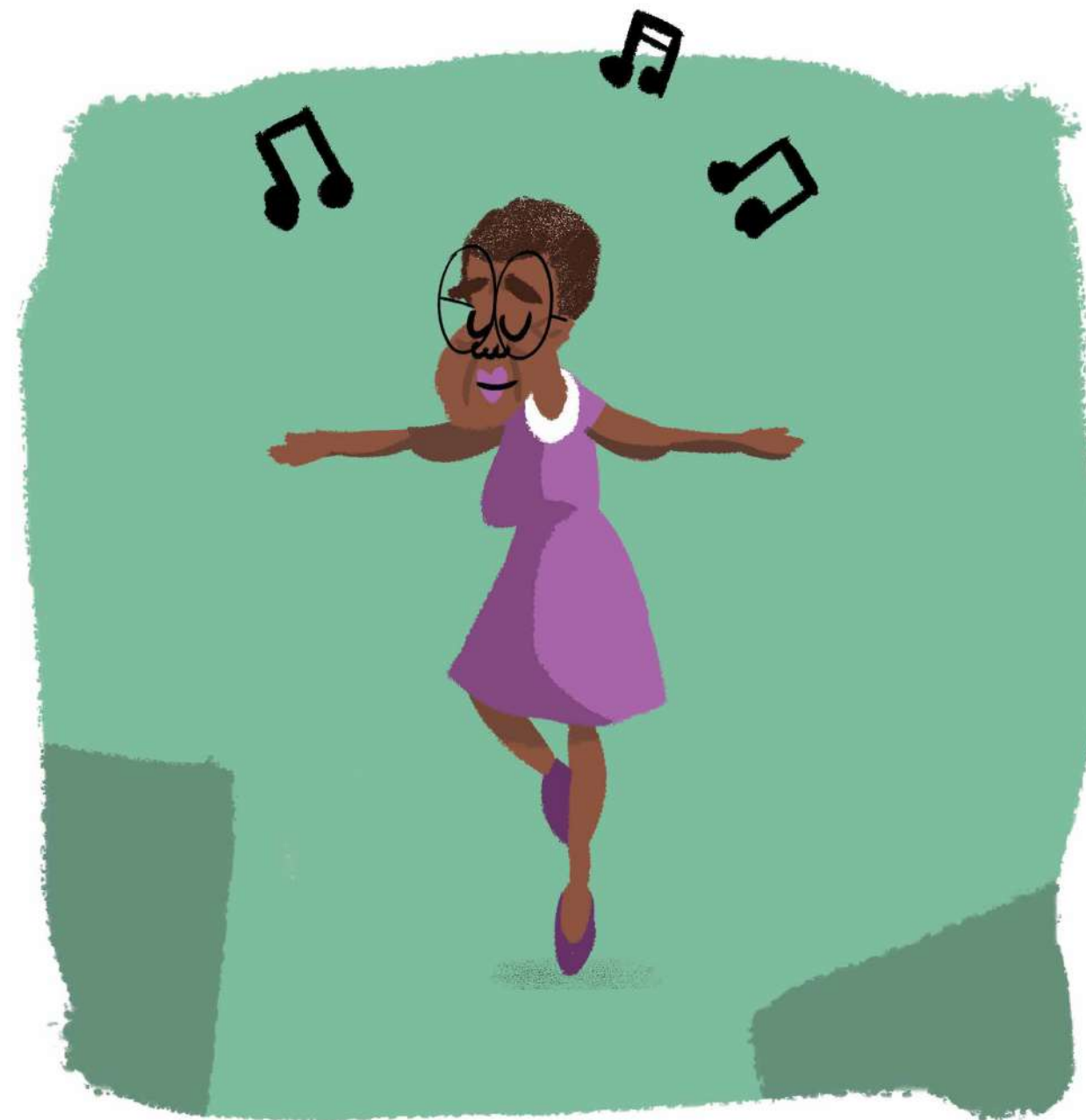


Singing granny
