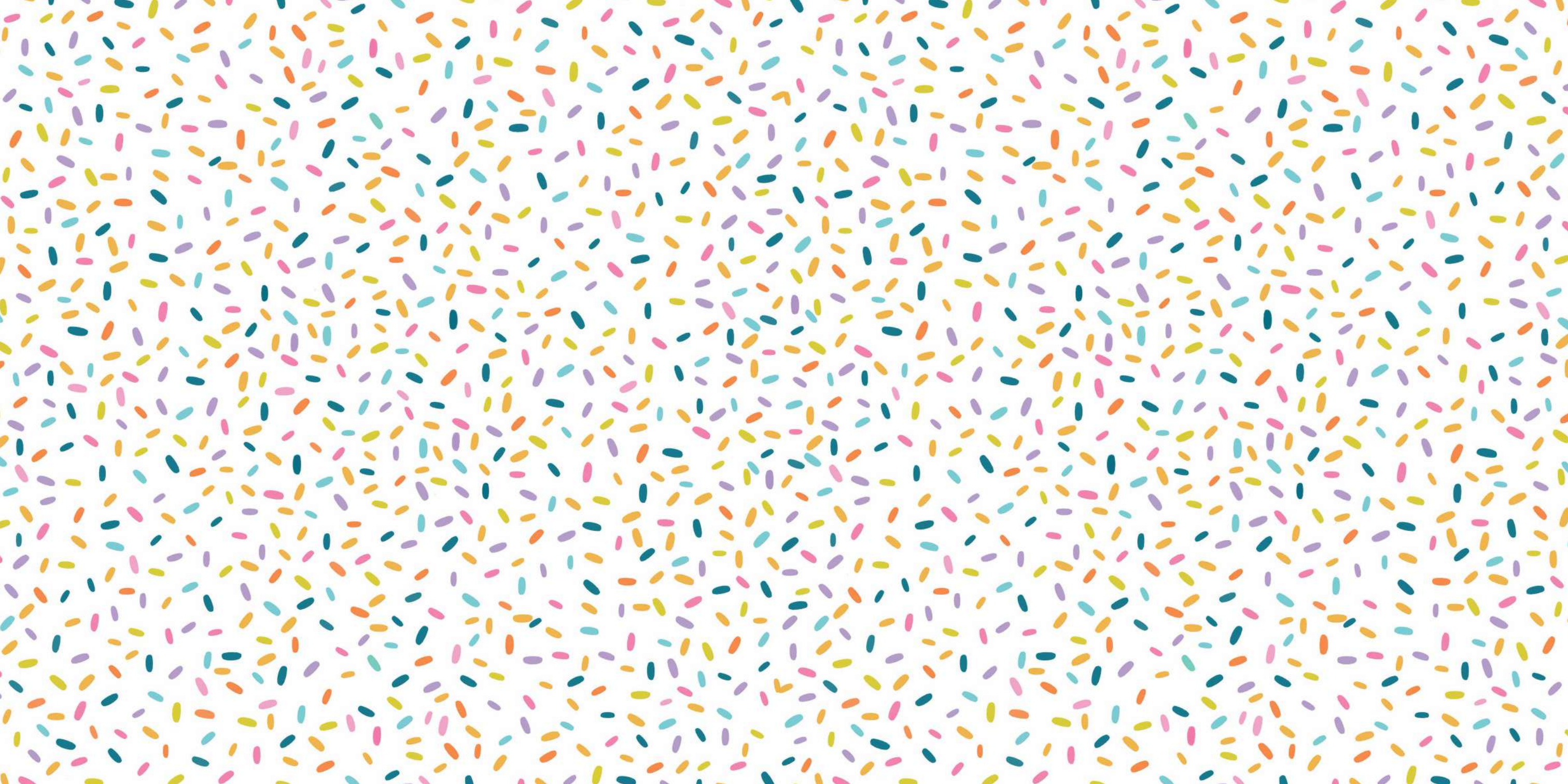

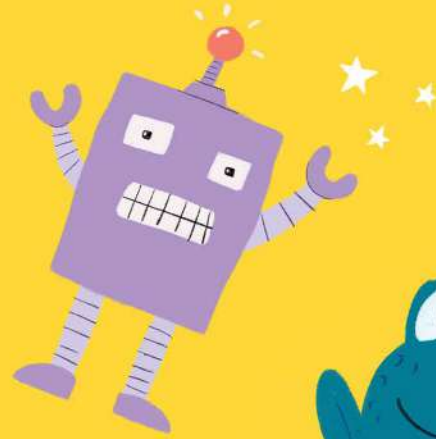

hop.

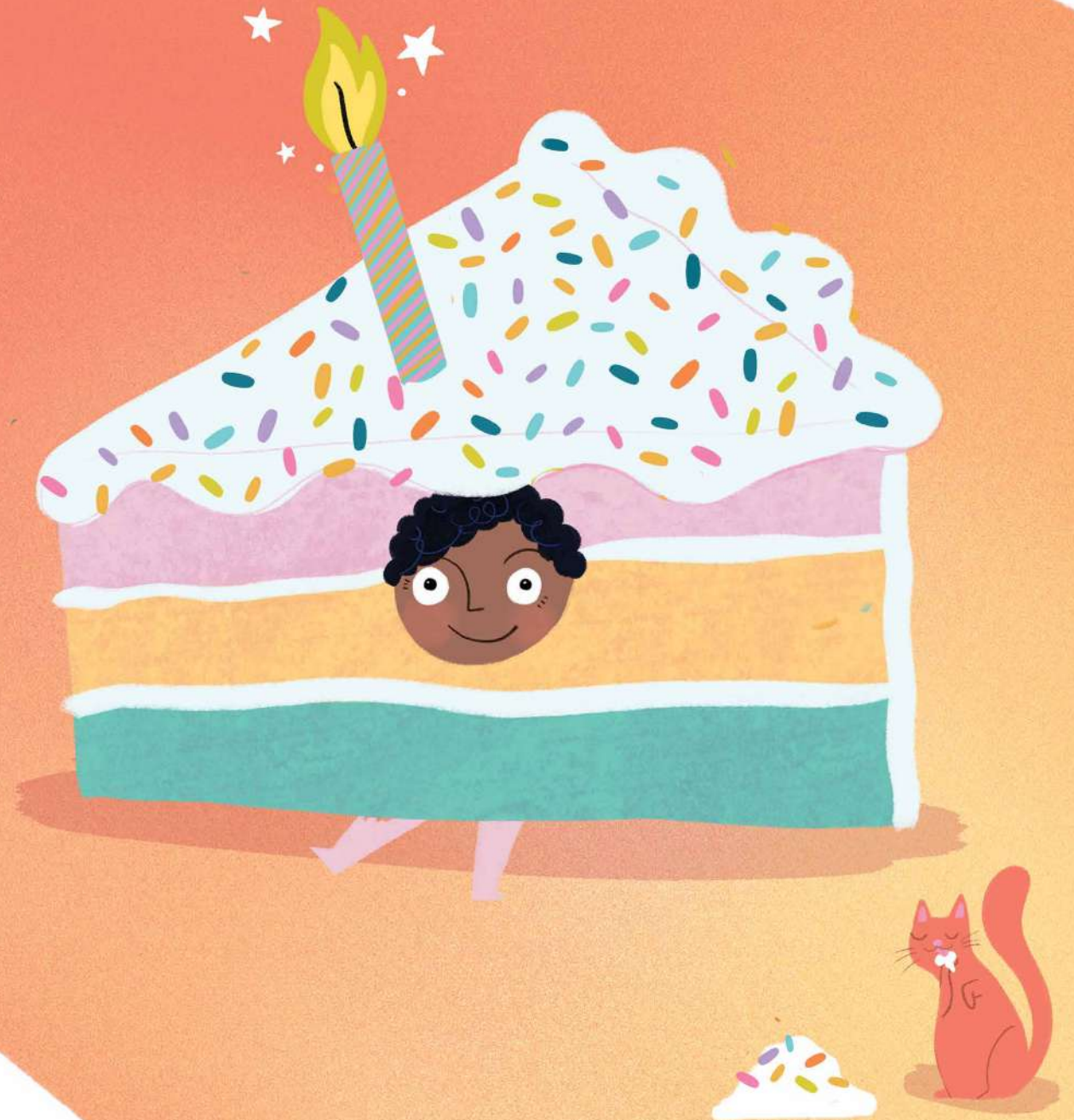
Or maybe

Wheeeeeeee!

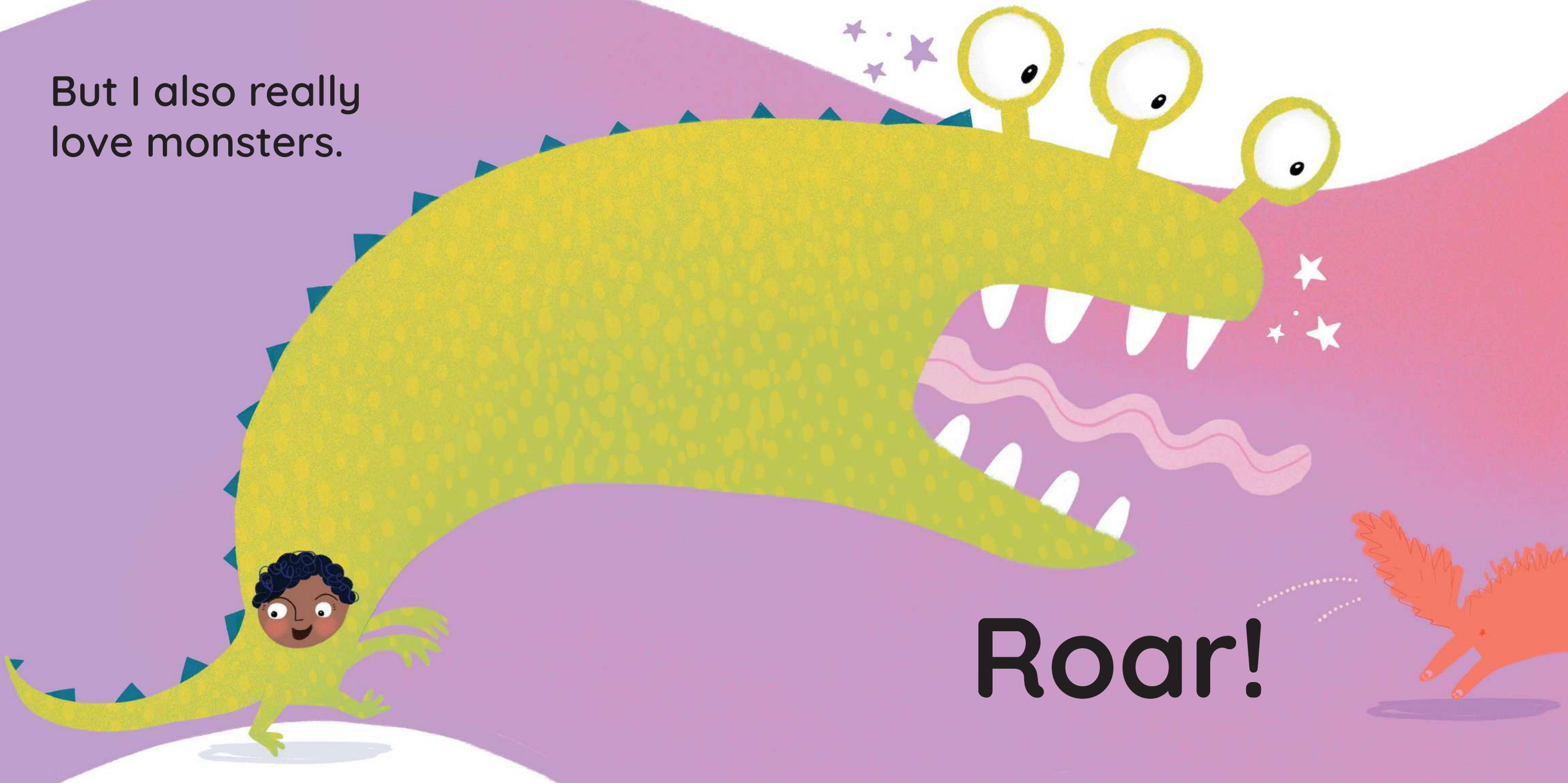
Or I could go
