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My Special Hair

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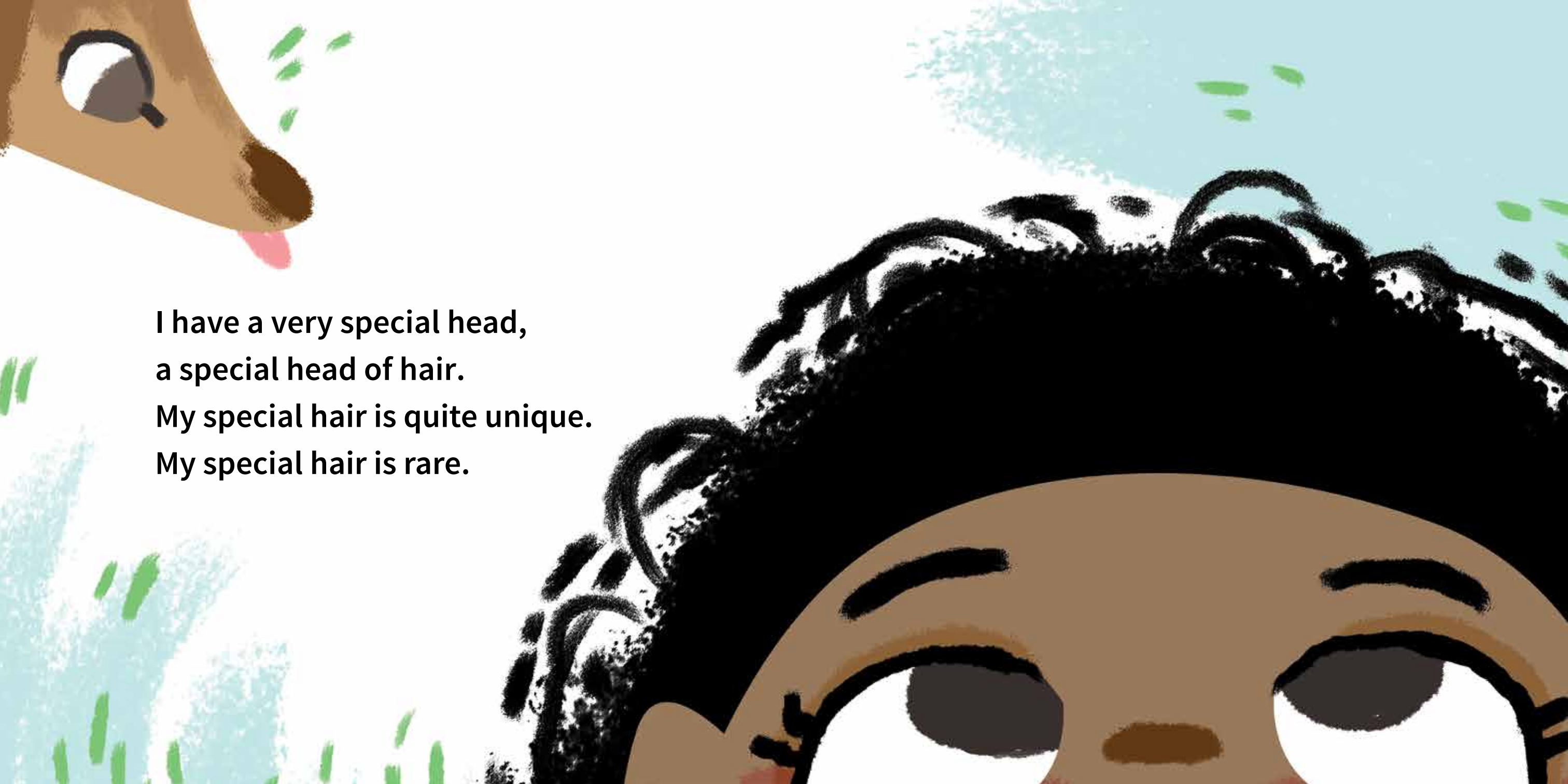

it's magic hair, you see.

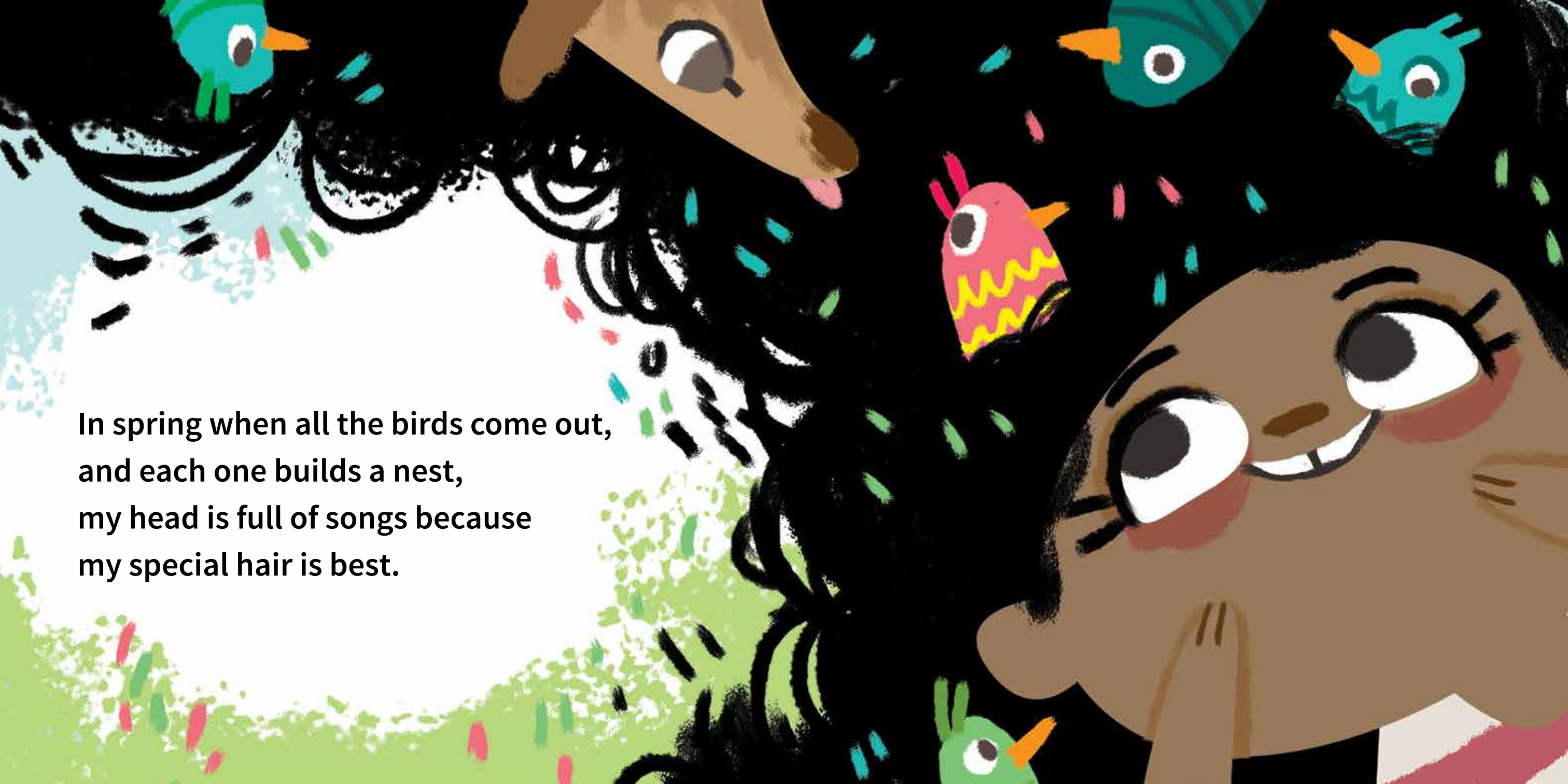




In summer when the sun is hot,

my hair can change its shape.





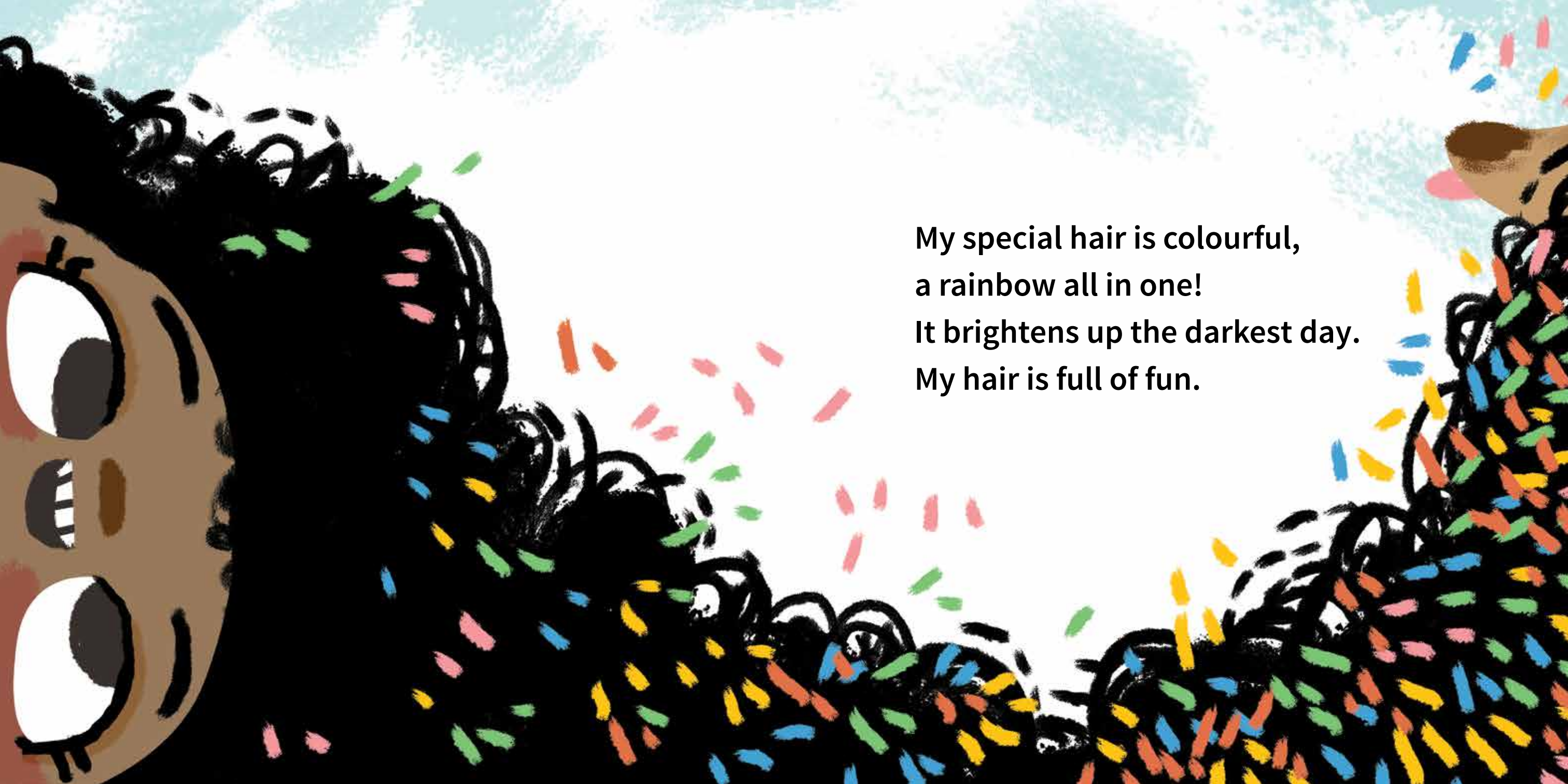
My special hair is full of curls.

so light.

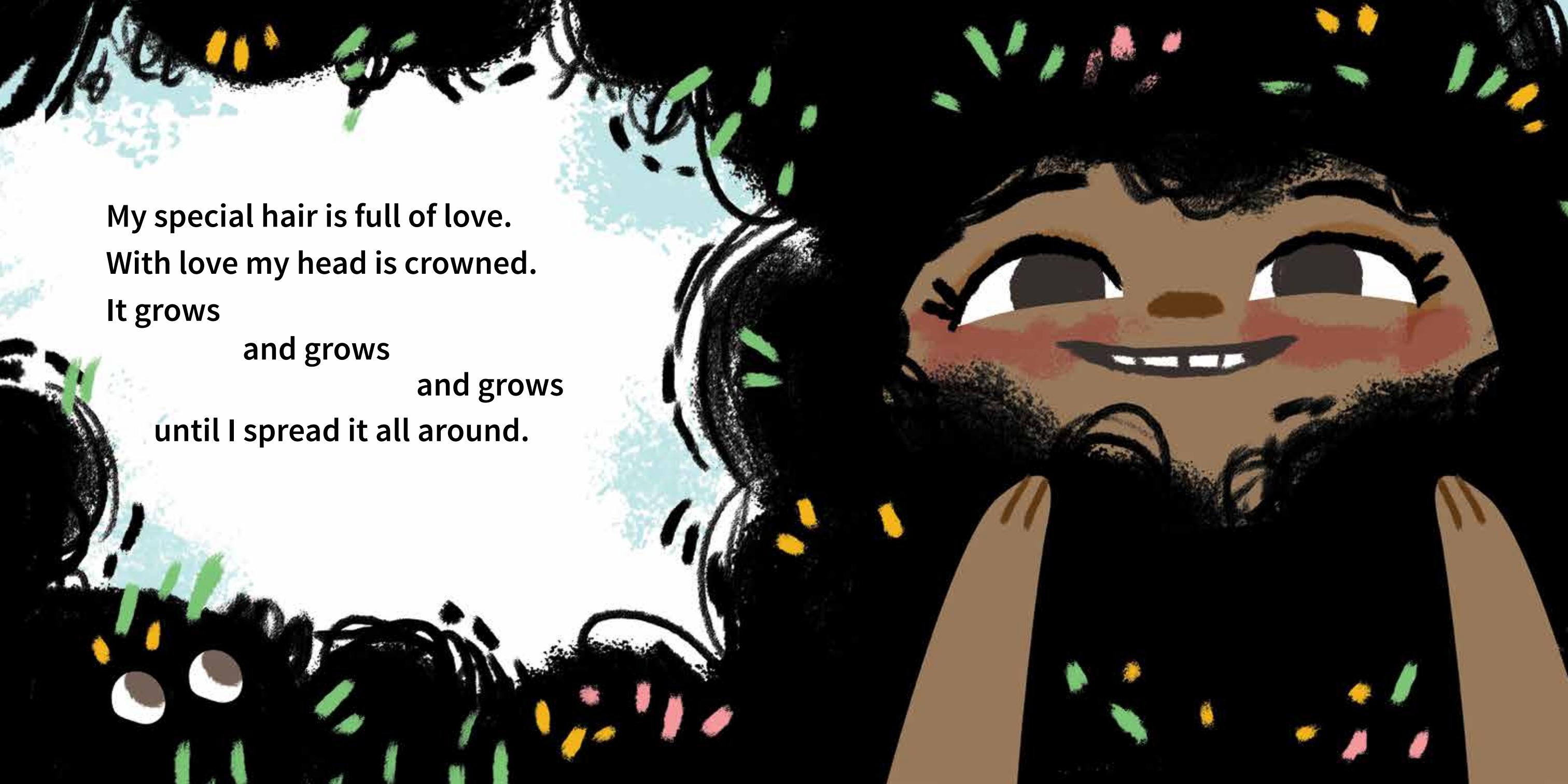
They float around my face,
