

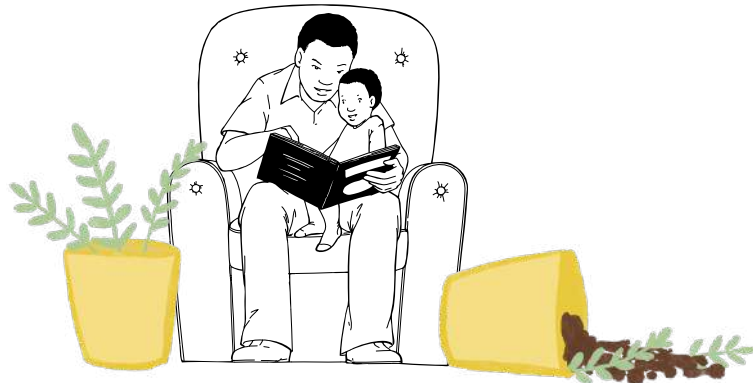


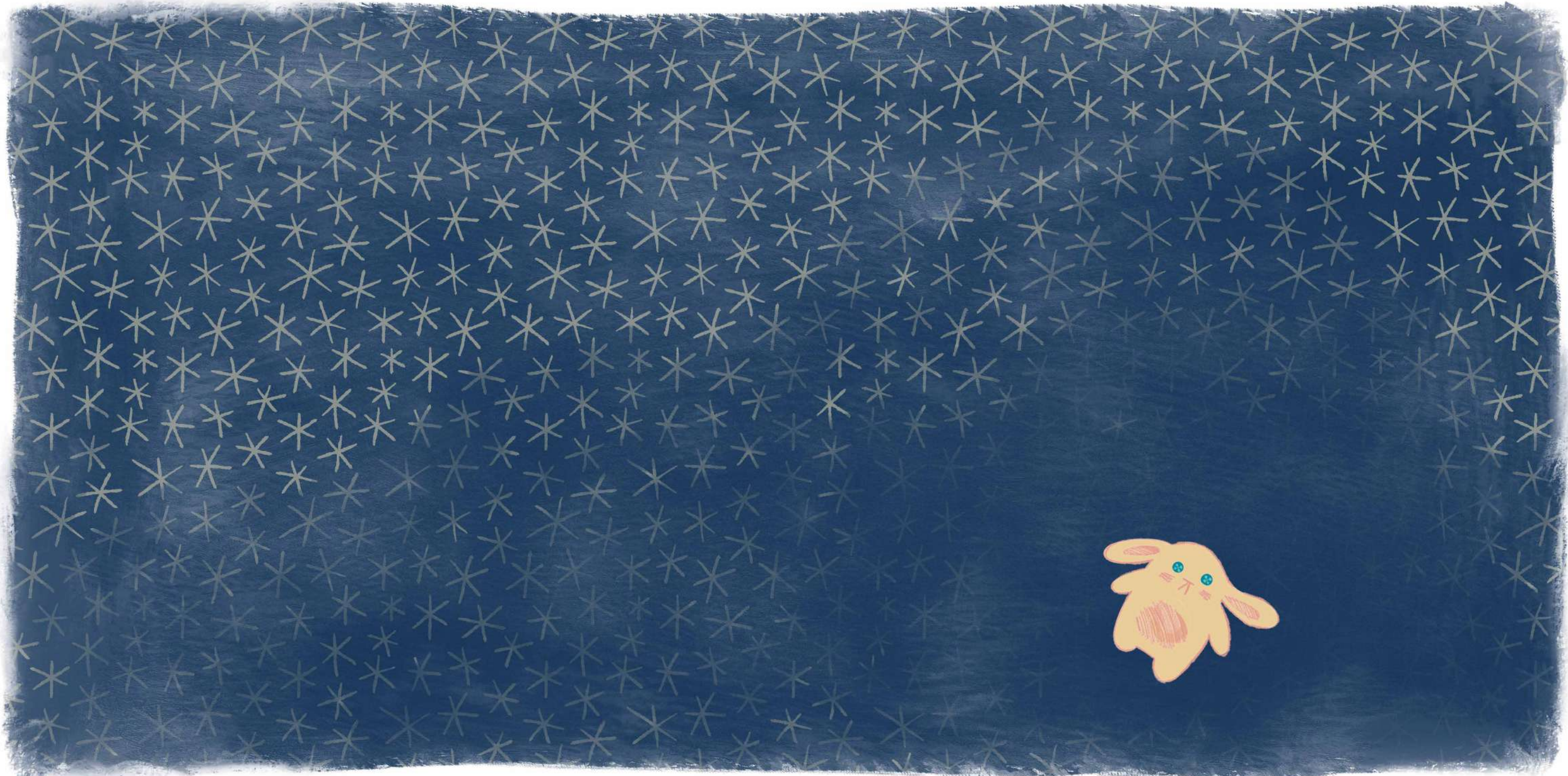

It wasn't **ALWAYS** here.

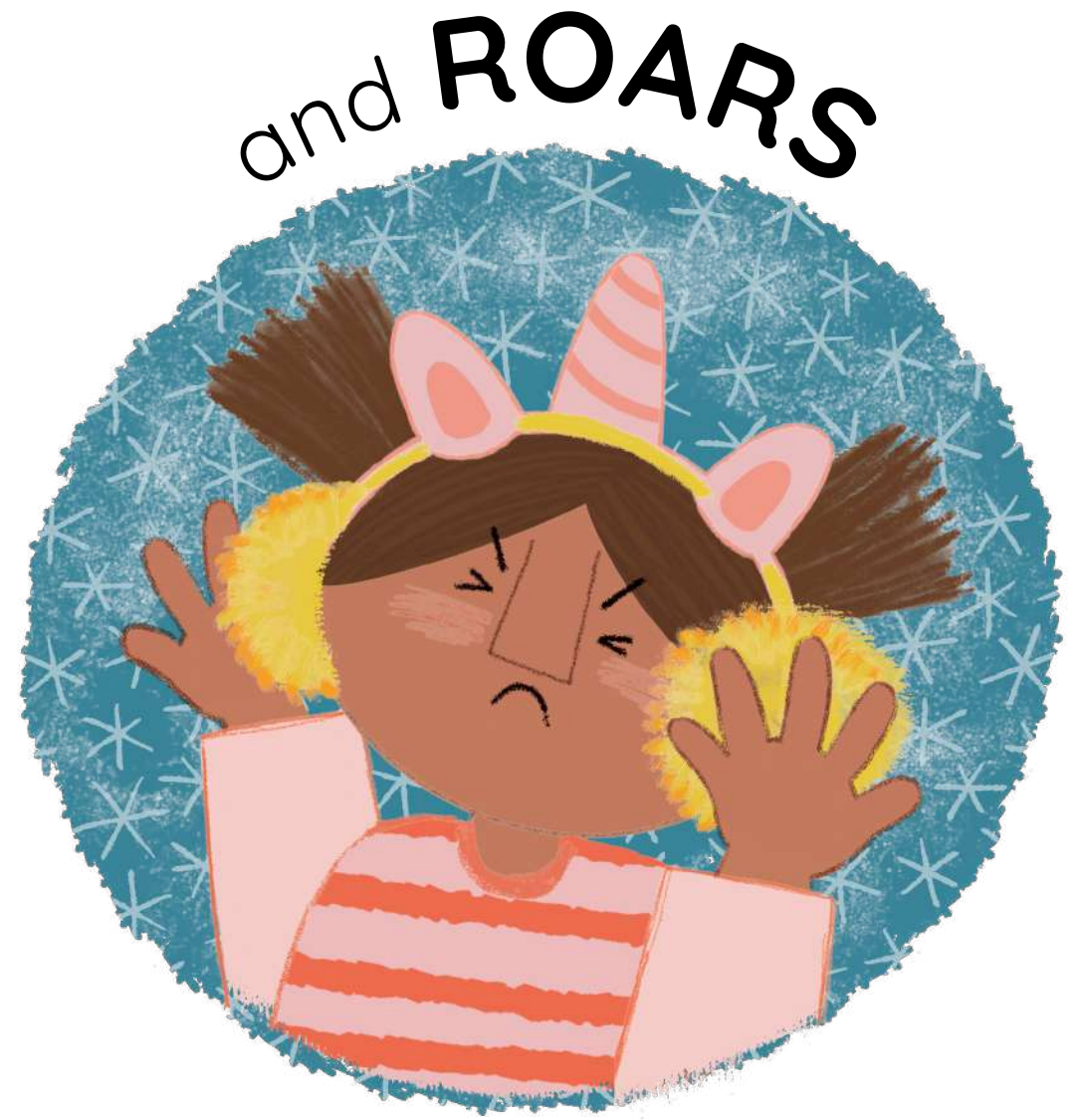




One day, it just

all day

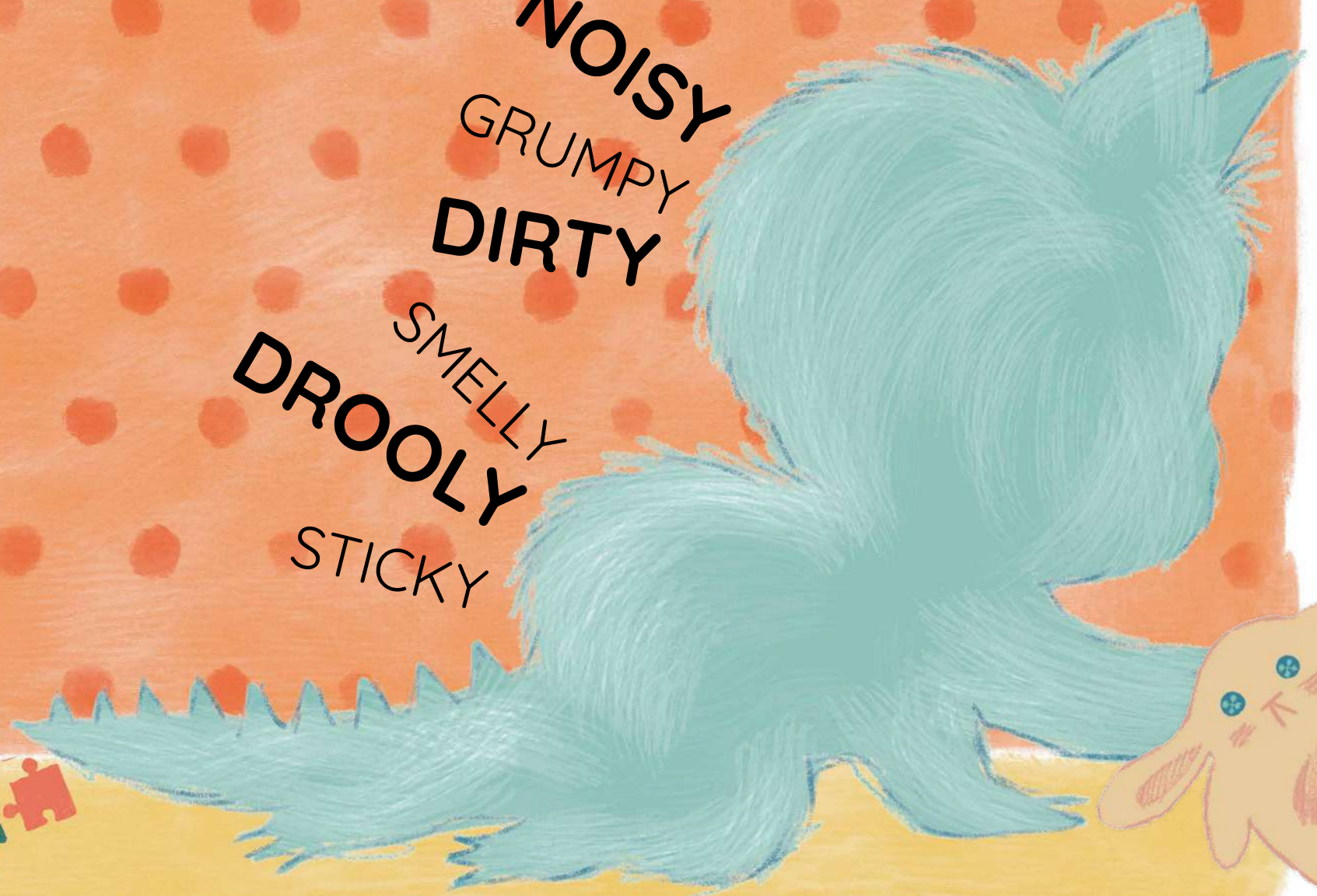


all night.

I tried **TRAPPING** it.



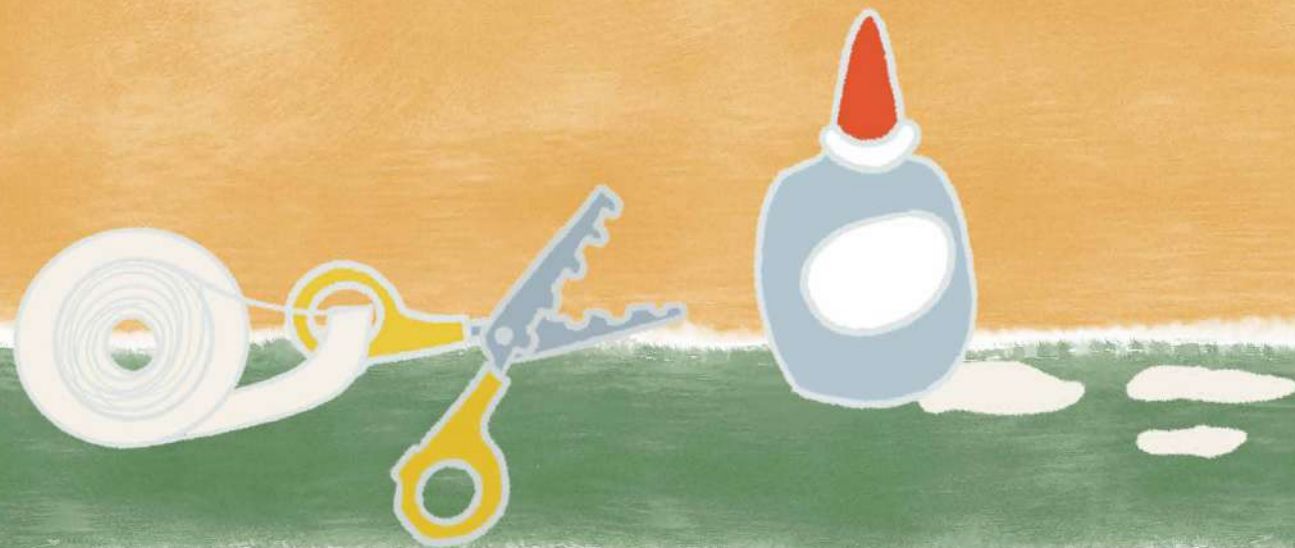
But the monster was

ANGRY.



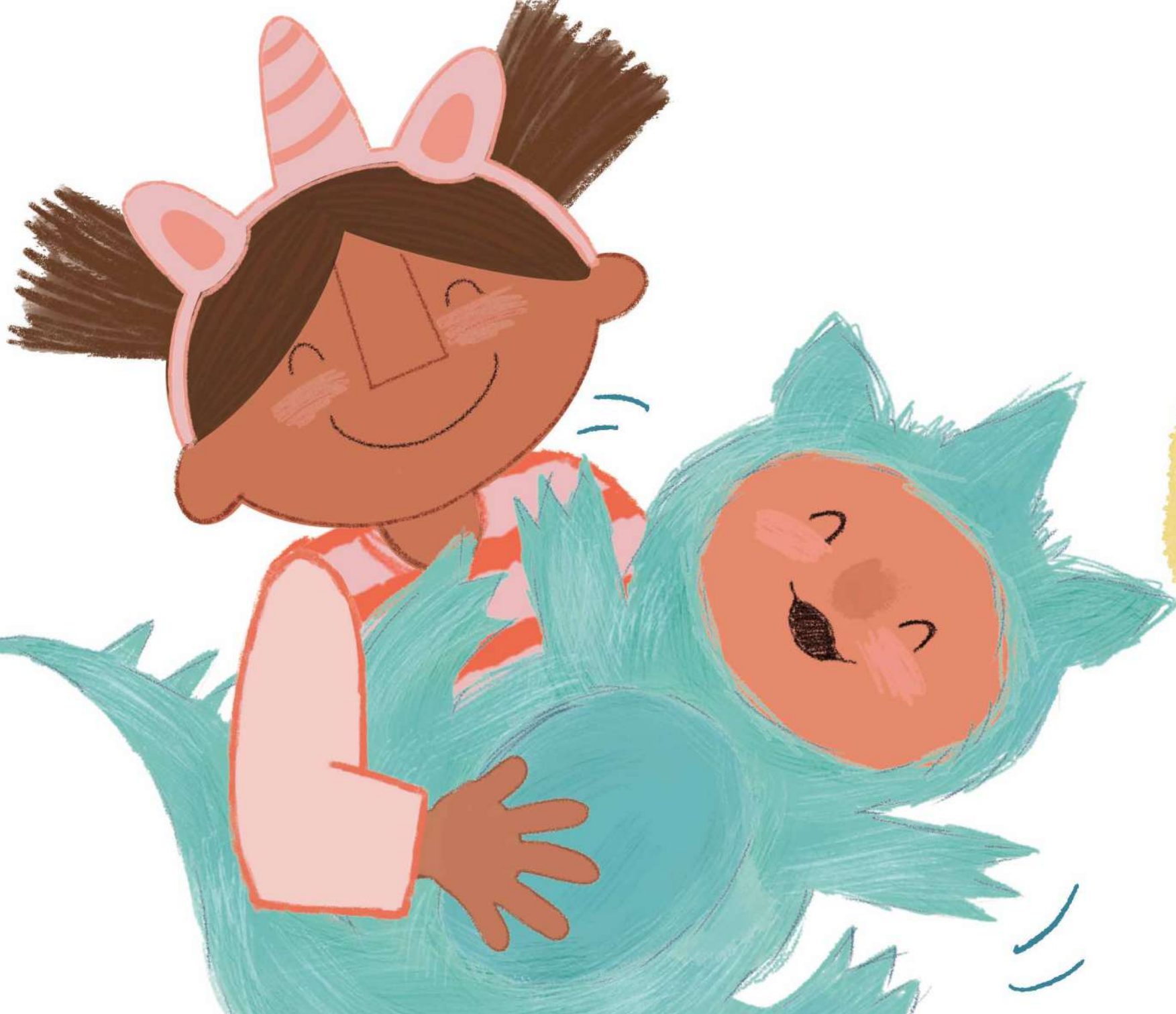


It's TOO LATE!
