

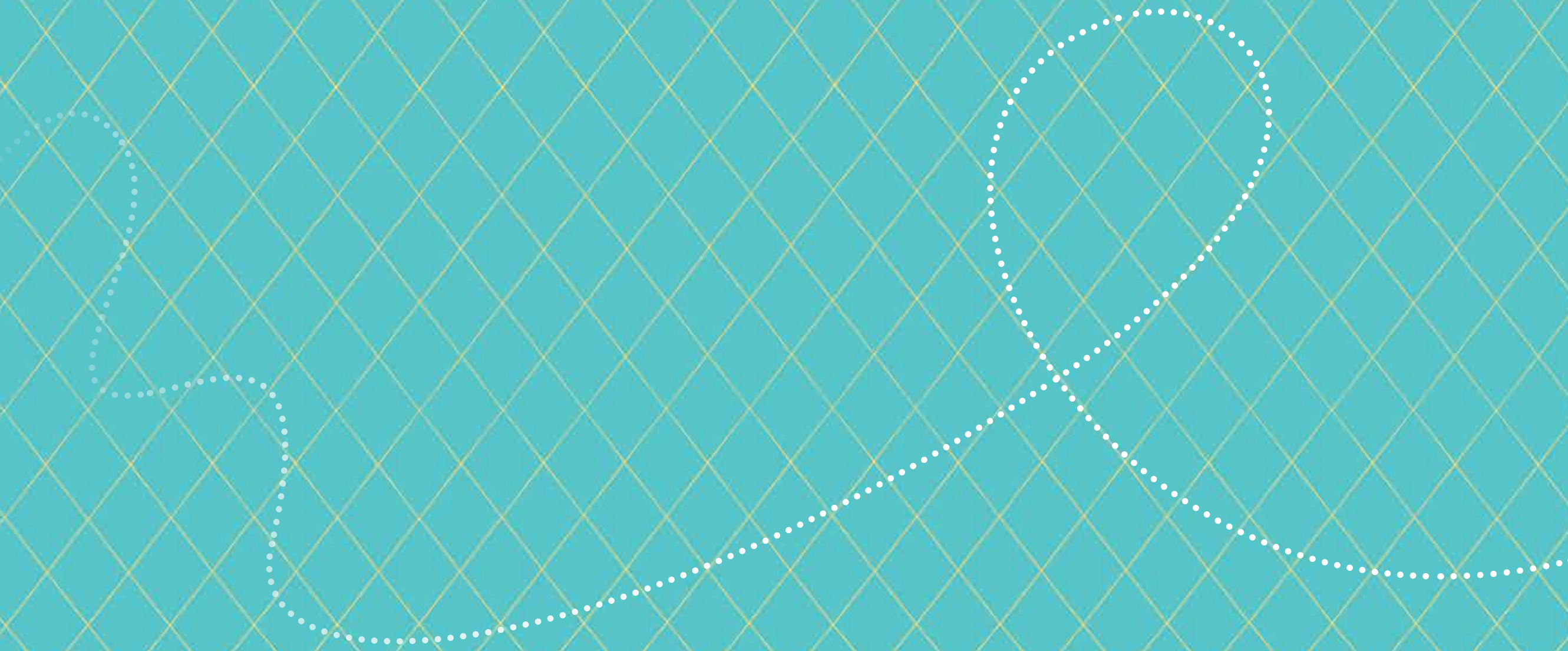
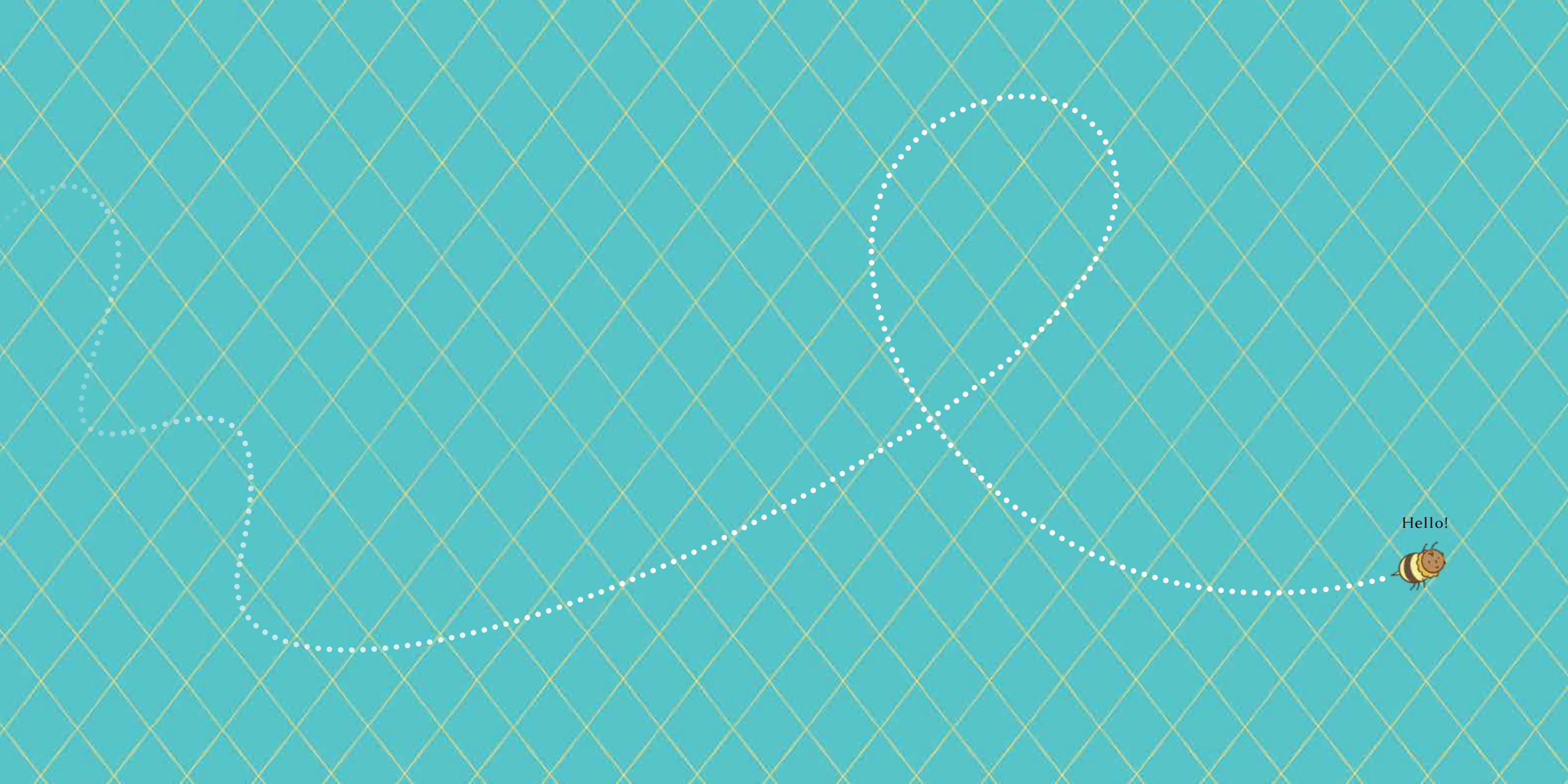

That baby's wiggly toes!

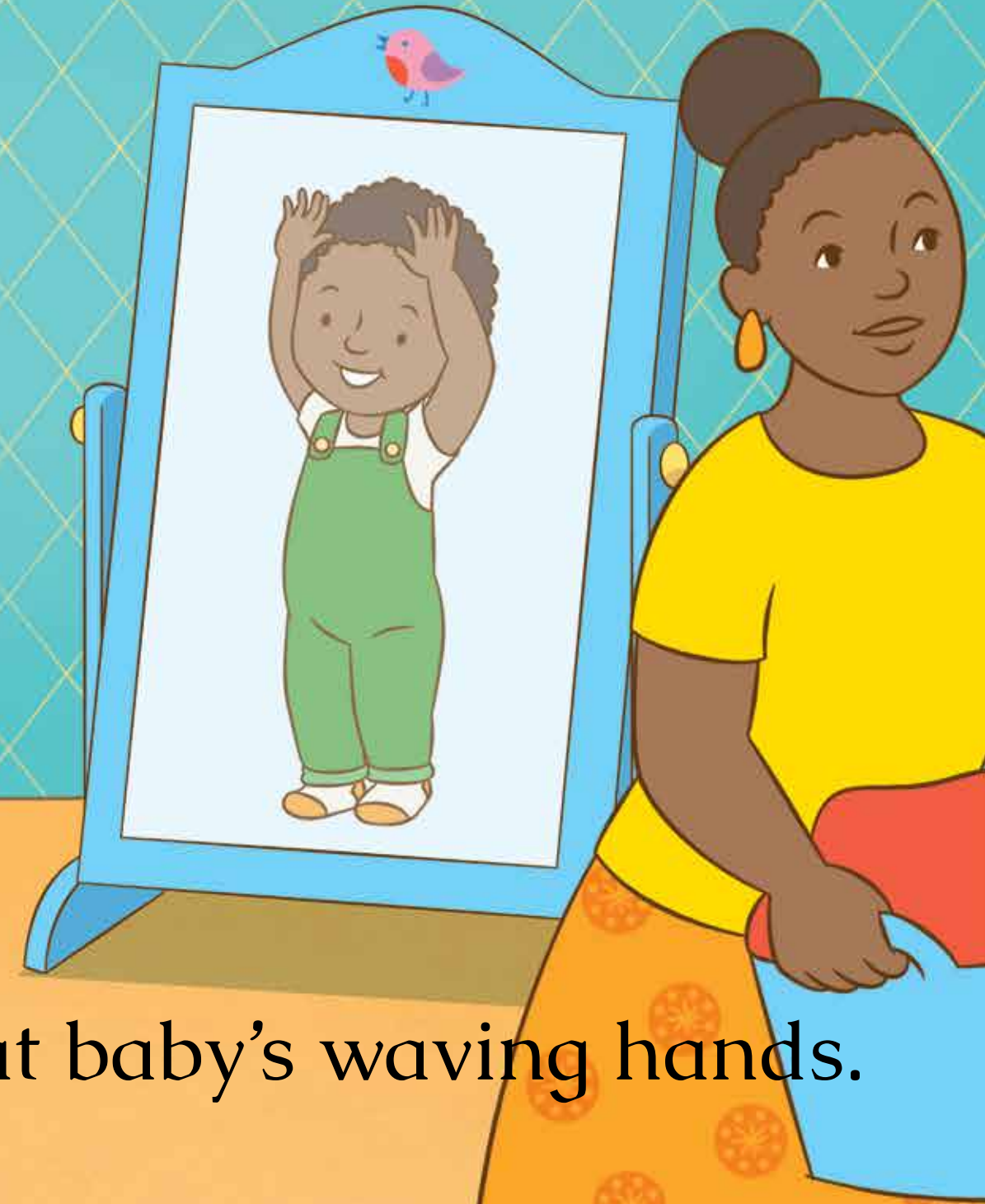

Oh, no! That baby's gone!



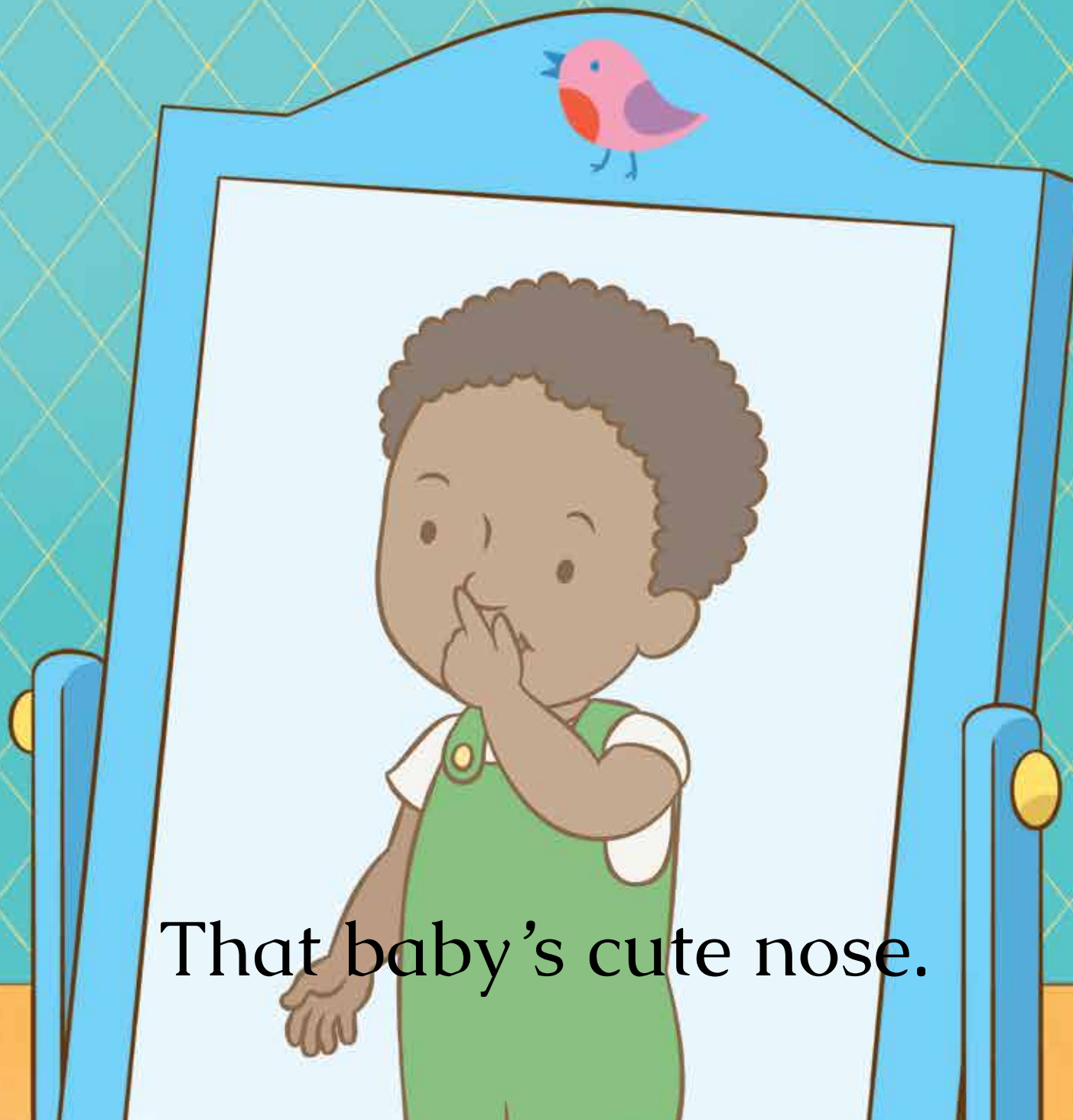

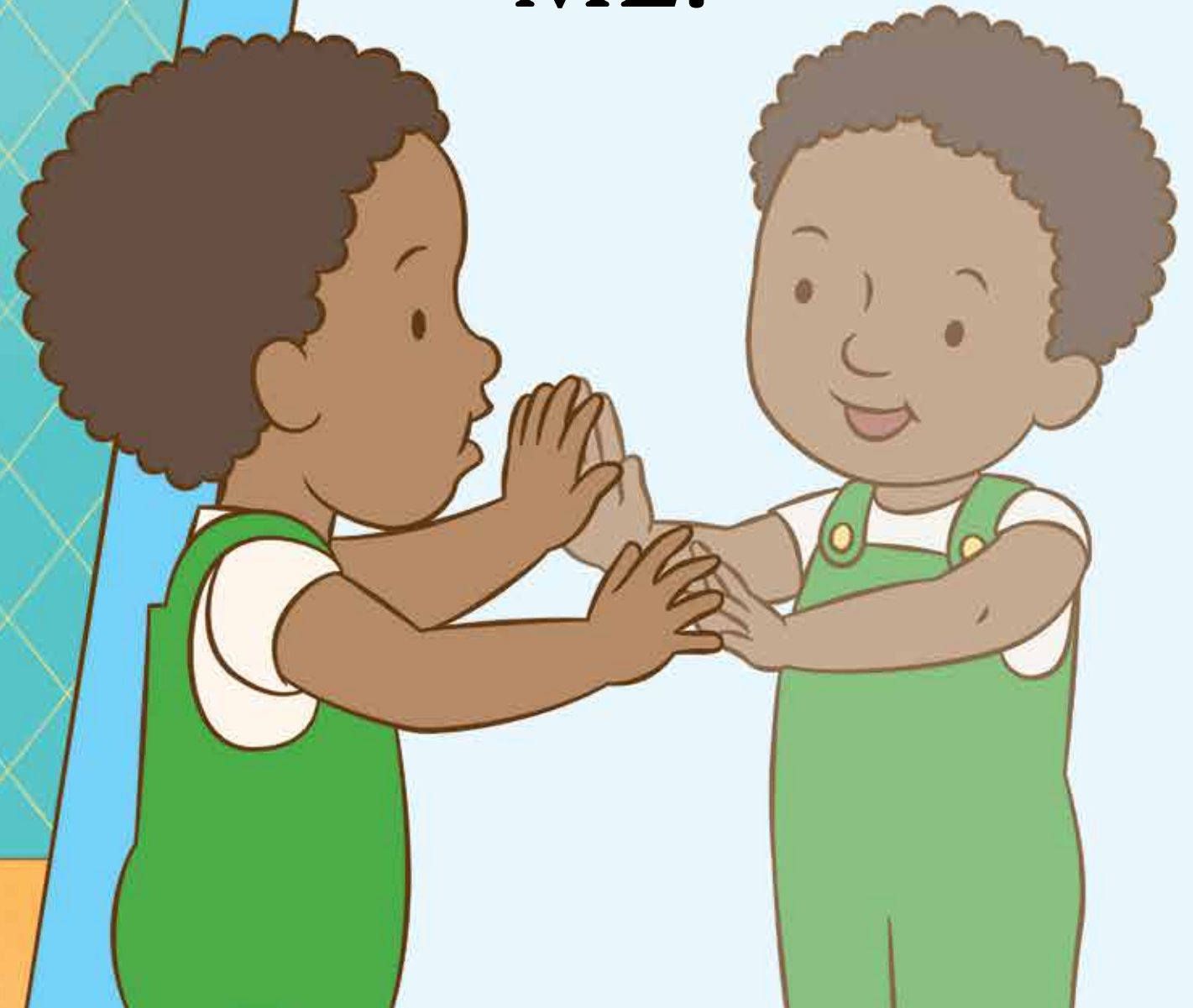


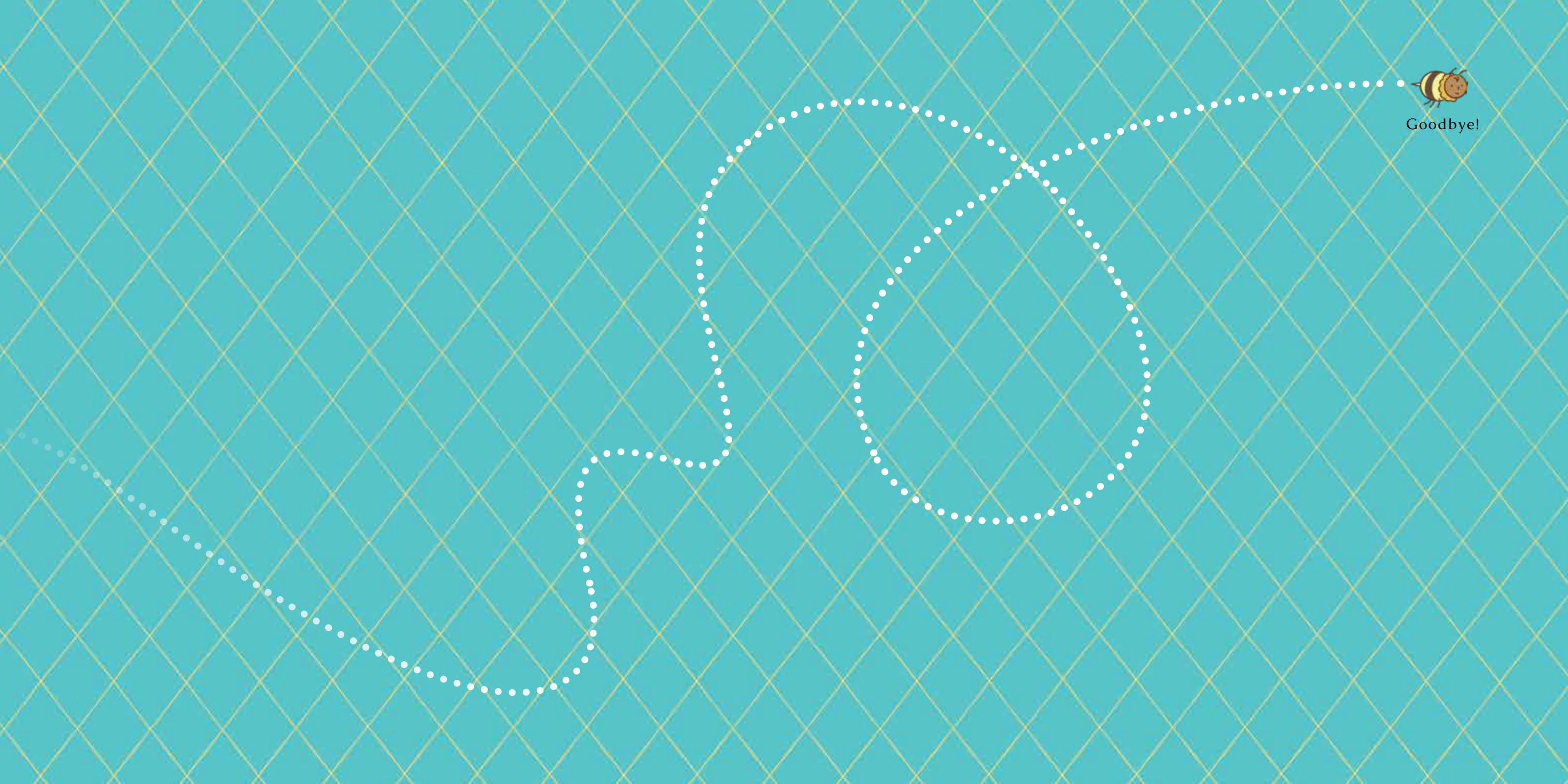
