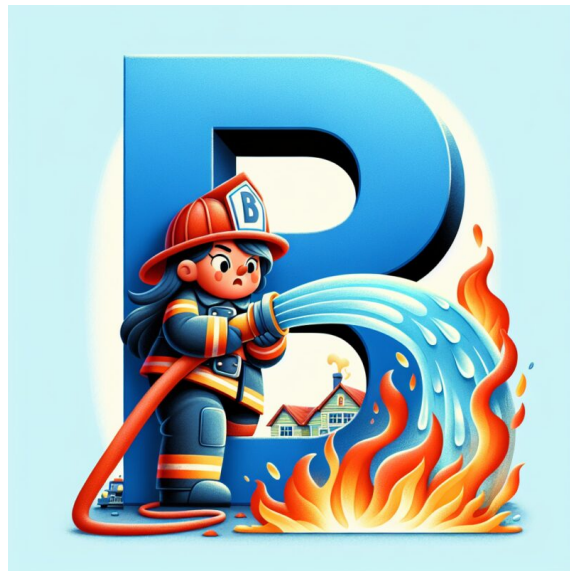
Firefighter ABC
