The police use it to find what's true.



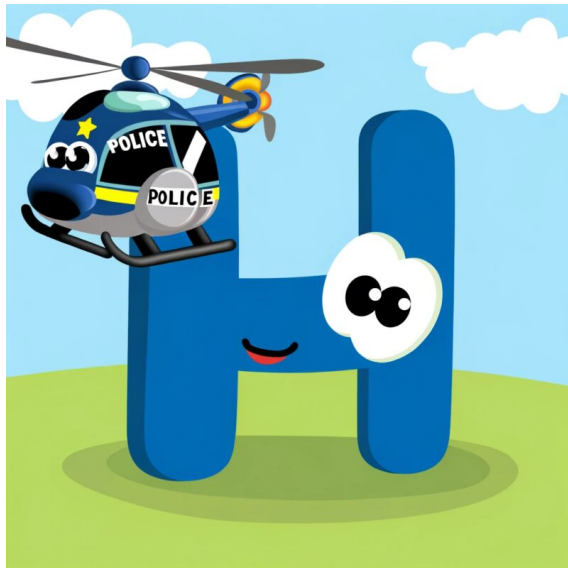
F is for Fingerprint, a clue that's just right,

For example for stealing cars.



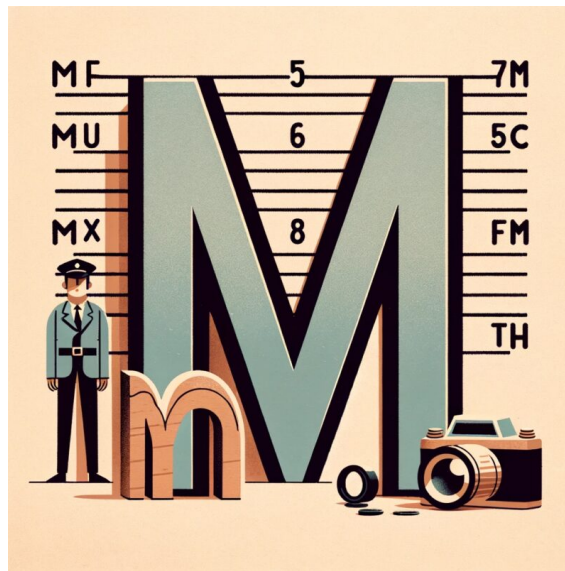
K is for K-9, a puppy so brave,

So when we're in need, we are not afraid.



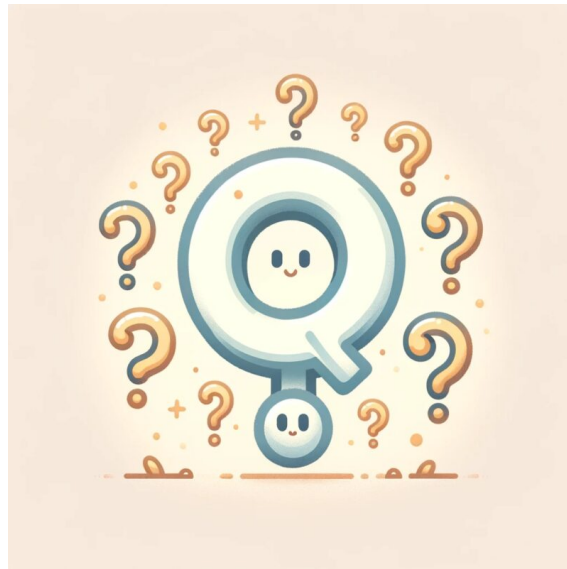
O is for Officer, ever so grand,

Helping to solve crimes, a very important task.



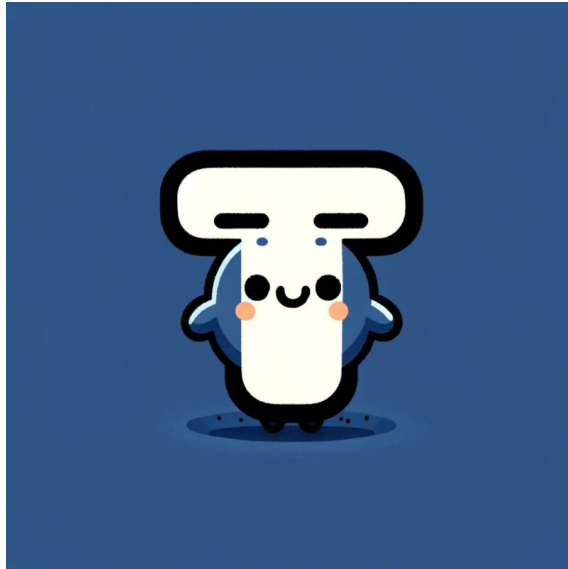
R is for Radio, with a beep and a blare,

With flashing blue lights and a big siren's beat.



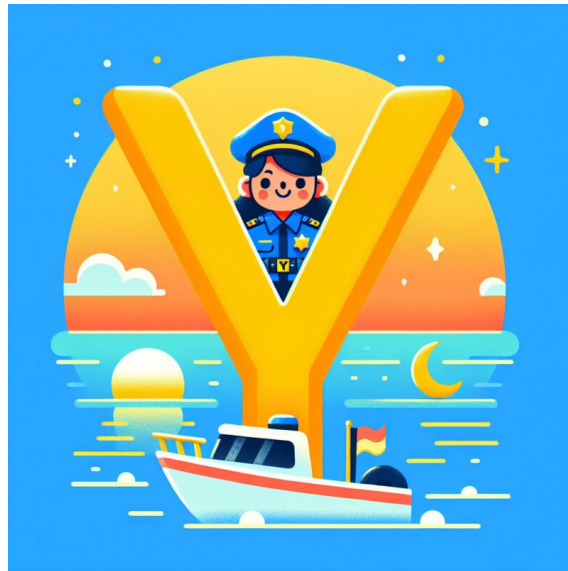
W is for Witness, who are brave and keen,
