



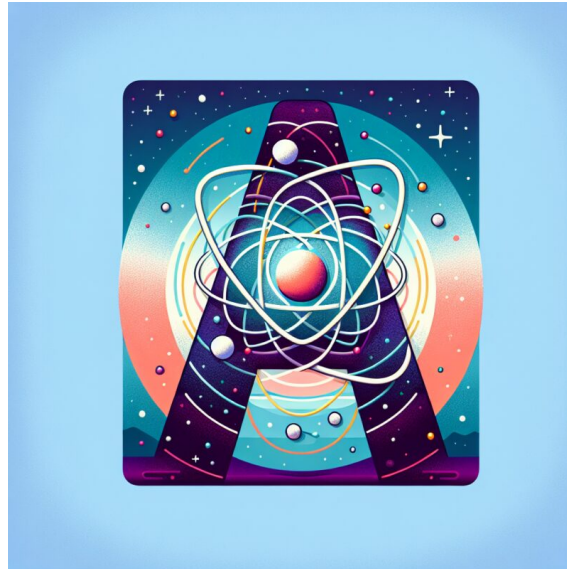

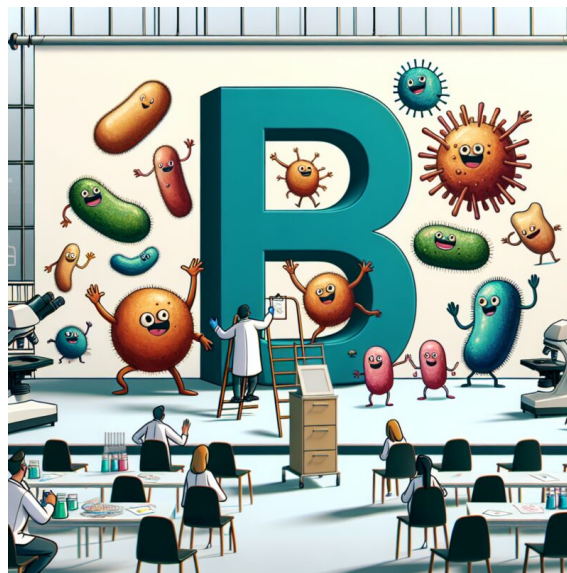

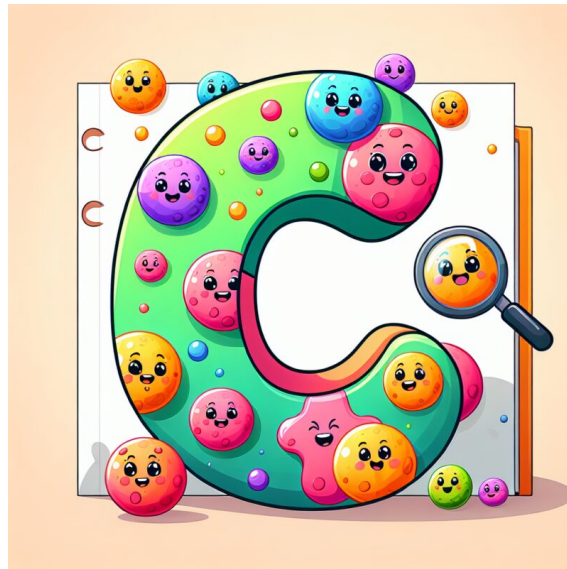
A is for Atom, small and unseen.

In our bodies, they're a surprise.



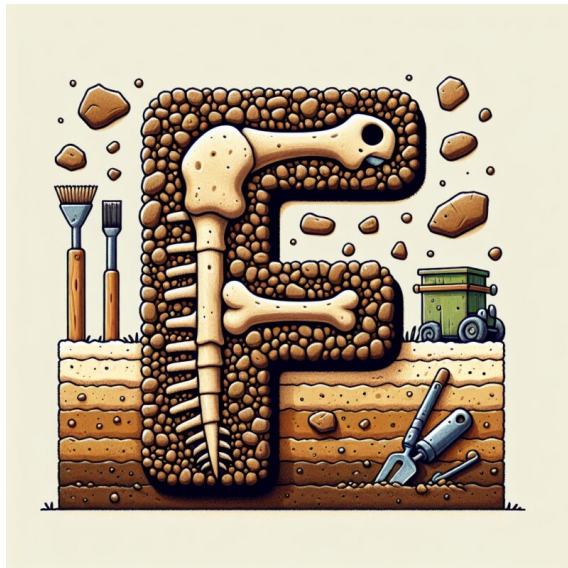
D is for DNA, deoxyribonucleic acid, long and twisty.
It copies itself, keeping life's instructions nifty.



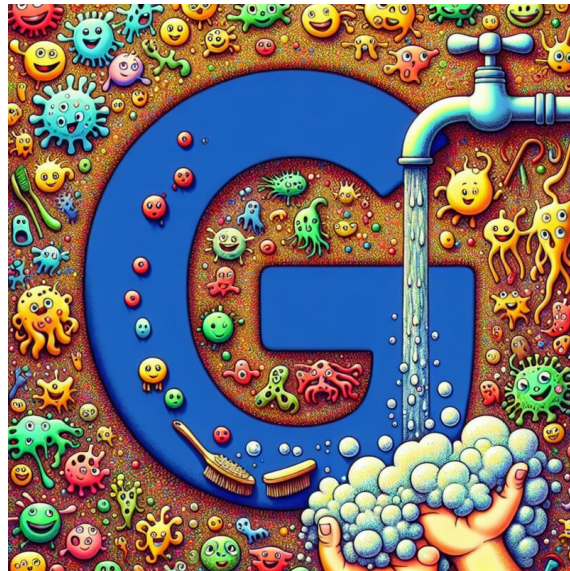
E is for Experiment, a playful way to learn,

It's the force of gravity, giving it its worth.



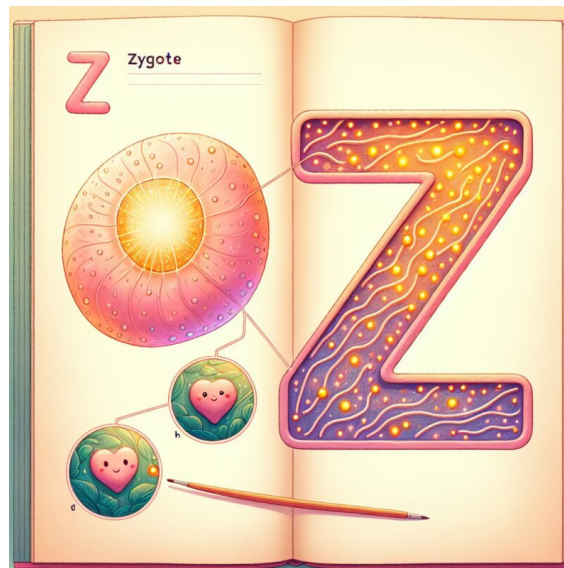
X is for X-Ray, that can see bones through skin,
