In spring, the world feels wonderfully whole.



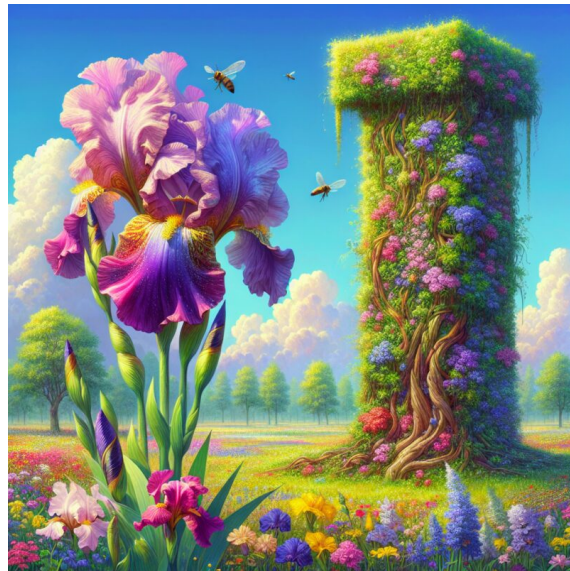
G is for Green, the colour of new leaves,

In the garden, lined in perfect row.



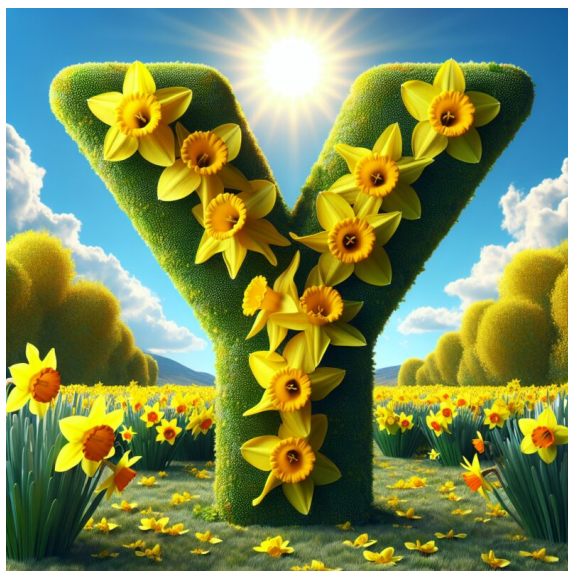
W is for Weather, a gentle spring breeze,
